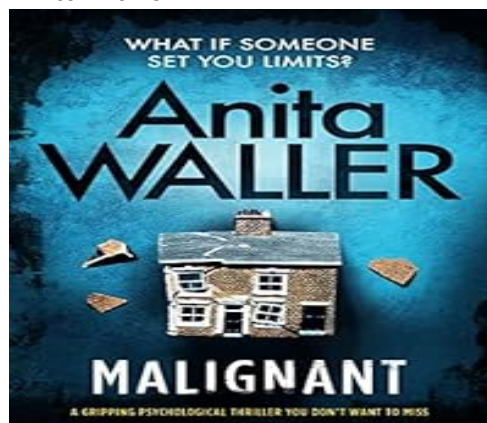


Malignant By Anita Waller The story actually deals with quite a few tough subjects.
