been dead before the action takes place and the relationship between him and the king in the book would have helped me to place the story a bit better. **The Earl of Mercias fatherof** There are a lot of people in the story with names that are very similar making it hard to follow at times; the names used are historically accurate but this might be an area where a bit of author's modification would have been a good idea to change or omit some of the repetitive names and lesser characters. **Earl of mercia macclesfield** Sometimes there is an excess of historical facts that really doesn't add to the story or depth of any of the characters; there are mentions of many persons who happened to be attending a gathering and have no other part in the story never mentioned again. **Leofric earl of mercia bookpedia** Paperback Initially I found this a little slow going however after the first chapter I got into and enjoyed it though the names are a bit confusing at times with several characters share the same names.

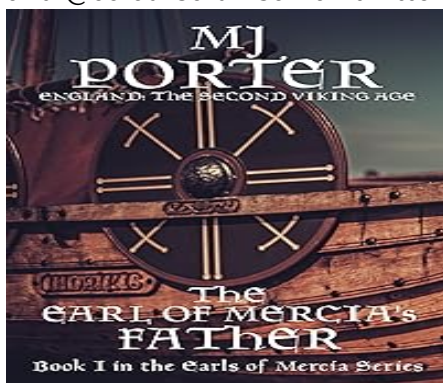
