The Magical Wish Tree: Bedtime stories for kids Teaching Children How to Be Caring Polite And Kind (Bedtime for Kids Book 1) A short picture book about a unicorn who believes she is not as beautiful as most of the others in her stable: It's amazing I love the unicorns and I love the wishing tree, One day she stumble across a magical wishing tree in the woods and asked him to grant her wish but she did not become beautiful, Instead Magical tree told her Golden words and changed her point of view altogether, Such a lovely book with gorgeous illustrations and a beautiful message related to self love, Typographical errors including the use of "u" instead of you, Part of the print was overlapped by the artwork making some words difficult to read, It reminds me of the stories I used to make up for the kiddos I babysat for to remind them of whatever problems we dealt with that day. One night Pixy sneaks out of the stable and finds a magical wishing tree. When she expresses a desire to be as beautiful on the outside as her friends the tree cautions her to look on the inside instead: Will Pixy follow the tree's advice? What will she learn about herself and others? This is a cute picture book with a message young readers need to hear.
